For those whose regular pickup day is on Christmas Day or New Year's Day your pickup will be one day later. Everyone else will be on regular schedule. As always, have rollcars and cans out by 5:30am.

Weather Alert!

If your garbage becomes buried in snow!

Here's how you can help us provide you with the best service. Please maintain access to rollcars, cans, containers and enclosures by clearing snow and ice. Our drivers are generally working by themselves and icy conditions or areas not shoveled can make it impossible for them to provide service. If you have an enclosure that is difficult to approach in winter, your container may need to be placed outside for collection. The new automated truck will need to have the rollcart in a clear opening.

Preparation of Recyclable Materials

Aluminum

Clean cans and foil, rinse and remove labels.

Tin Cans

Clean, remove labels. No dirty or rusty cans, paint or aerosol cans.

Corrugated Cardboard/Brown Bags

Flatten. No slick or wax-coated.

Glass Bottles & Jars

Clean, remove lids. No ceramics, pyrex, light bulbs, mirrors, baking dishes, or window glass.

Magazines, Catalogs & Newspapers

As is.

Mixed Paper

Junk mail, paper, envelopes, white & colored paper, computer paper, tin can labels, wrapping paper (no foil or ribbon), shredded paper (strips only, no confetti).

Paperboard

Cereal/cracker/shoe boxes, soda & beer cartons, paper egg cartons, paper towel tubes.

Plastic Bottles & Jugs

Includes milk jugs, pop & water bottles, yogurt & margarine type tubs, etc. Clean. No lids or dirty bottles.



E-Waste Update

Effective January 1, 2009,

computers, televisions and monitors will no longer be accepted for disposal at Knott Landfill or any County Transfer Stations. These items will be accepted free of charge at Knott Landfill Recycling Center from households, small businesses, non-profits with 10 or fewer employees and anyone with 7 or fewer computers, monitors and televisions. Route Information

Please do not pack rollcarts or cans. If cans are packed tight, they cannot be readily emptied and left over garbage will remain in the cart. You will have to loosen this garbage yourself before our truck comes back the next week. This is especially a problem in the winter, with garbage freezing in the bottom. It is recommended that garbage be bagged.

Unacceptable materials in garbage cans & carts:

Ashes, Dirt, Rocks, Concrete, large chunks of Styrofoam, Liquids, Animal Waste, Medical Sharps, and hazardous waste.

To insure your rollcart is emptied on the collection day, we ask that the rollcart be outside by 5:30am, or the night before. If the rollcart is not out in time we will not be able to come back.

Winter Road Conditions: If roads and driveways are not plowed wide enough, our garbage truck may not be able to make it through.

New Truck on the Job

Some of our customers are being serviced by a new automated truck. This means that the truck does most of the work. It picks the rollcart up with a hydraulic arm. Which requires a clear area of four feet around your rollcart. This new system will help us do the job more efficiently.

SecureShred

SecureShred is a division of Bend Garbage & Recycling and is an on-site document destruction service that meets the National Association for Information Destruction AAA standards. SecureShred comes to La Pine the 1st and 3rd Monday of every month. We will gladly store your paperwork in locked rollcarts to be shredded when they come by. No more than 2 file boxes or 2-12 gallon bags please. Call Wilderness Garbage if you have any questions.

Automated Payment Plan

We offer the convenience of our Auto Pay credit card payment. You will receive a statement with an amount due showing, but will state "Do Not Pay." Your credit card will be debited (charged) on the 10th of the month once you have signed the paperwork.
